

Care and Maintenance

Wood Case Goods

Our case good products are crafted from sustainable harvested solid woods and veneers. A minimum of attention will ensure their long lasting beauty and functionality.

Every case good order is shipped with a touch up kit (including matching stain color) for those minor damages occurring during the handling or installation of our product.

For every day maintenance, follow these simple recommendations:

- As with all wood products, avoid excessive moisture.
- Wipe up any spills and water marks as they occur.
- Clean with a damp cloth and wipe dry.
- Wood finishes can be cleaned and protected by using any commercially available cleaning polish. These are formulated without petroleum solvents or silicone that will deteriorate the surface finish.
- Belstone recommends an emulsion type such as Murphy's® Oil Soap (Please refer to the product instructions for proper use).
- Never use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads or powdered cleansers.

Laminate Case Goods

Belstone's exterior and exterior plastic laminate panels used in the manufacture of its case good products are extremely durable and designed to give you years of beauty and trouble free service.

Every case good order is shipped with a touch up kit (including matching stain color) for those minor damages occurring during the handling or installation of our product.

For every day maintenance, follow these simple recommendations:

- As with all wood products, avoid excessive moisture. Wipe up any spills and water marks as they occur.
- Clean with a damp cloth and wipe dry.
- They can be cleaned with most household cleaners. However, agents containing acetone, acetate or ethyl alcohol should not be used.
- Harsh solvents and/or abrasives such as turpentine may break down bonds on edgebanding and should also be avoided.

Care and Maintenance

Stainless Steel Case Goods

Our stainless steel case good products are crafted from #304 stainless steel for strength and durability.

Stainless steel is very resistant to rust, however it is not impervious to it and we recommend frequent cleaning in order to preserve its corrosion resistance properties.

For every day maintenance, follow these simple recommendations:

- Clean with mild soap and water or glass cleaner and a cotton cloth.
- Fingerprints can be removed with a commercial glass cleaner.
- **AVOID** chloride containing cleansers.
- **AVOID** muriatic acid (commonly used to clean up after tile/concrete installation).
- **AVOID** contact with iron materials.
